Shake container before use: COOPERS PANACUR 25 is ready to use, no dilution or mixing is necessary. COOPERS PANACUR 25 may be administered orally through standard drenching equipment. Wash equipment after use in clean water.

COOPERS PANACUR 25 does not stain wool or skin or predispose animals to photosensitisation, COOPERS PANACUR 25 is palatable and readily accepted by livestock, COOPERS PANACUR 25 is active against both mature (adult) and immature (larval) nematode parasites, COOPERS PANACUR 25 has activity (80% to 90%) against inhibited (hypobiotic) larvae of Ostertagia in cattle, COOPERS PANACUR 25 is ready to use and non-clogging. COOPERS PANACUR 25 may be administered concurrently with vaccines, letting and dipping operations and pour-on lice treatments. COOPERS PANACUR 25 has ovicidal activity in sheep and goats, reducing worm egg hatching. For this to be of benefit, sheep and goats should not be placed on clean pasture until 12 hours have elapsed after drenching. Resistance may develop to any drench and it is advisable that a drench resistance test be conducted before any drench is used. Ask your local veterinary practitioner or animal health adviser for recommended parasite management practices for your area to reduce development of resistance.
